RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TRANSPORT FEES

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLALLAM COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT No. 3, TO INCREASE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES TRANSPORT FEES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2025, AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER BASED ON THE INCREASE IN THE SEATTLE-TACOMA-BELLEVUE CPI-U JUNE INDEX RATE.

BACKGROUND, it is the judgment of the Board of Commissioners of the District that it is essential and necessary for the protection of the health and life of the residents of the District that fire and emergency medical services be provided by the District.

WHEREAS, the accelerated demands for, and increasing costs of, providing these services necessitate the continued expenditure of revenues for personnel, operations and equipment at a level that is not reflected in current rates.

WHEREAS, the District has previously established transport rates and last confirmed such rates in March of 2012.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has determined that it is in the best interest of the District that the emergency medical transport rates be adjusted annually to keep up with the costs of inflation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 3, in Clallam County, Washington, that the emergency medical services transport fees shall be established as below effective January 1, 2025:

BLS Base \$1,100.00

ALS 1 Base \$1,400.00

ALS 2 Base \$1,450.00

Mileage \$24.00 per mile

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the emergency medical services transport fees shall be adjusted annually on the first of January based on the increase in the Seattle-Tacoma-Bellevue CPI-U June index rate with a minimum of zero percent.
