A JOINT RESOLUTION SUPPORTING EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Sequim identified locating an emergency medical facility within the City limits as a goal in 2016; and

WHEREAS, Clallam County Fire District 3 established the goal of an emergency medical facility in Sequim as a result of a fire service study in 2016; and

WHEREAS, a majority of Clallam County Fire District 3's medical calls for service occur in the Sequim City limits; and

WHEREAS, both organizations spent time independently talking with Olympic Medical Center staff and other providers about their objectives; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the public safety for Sequim's citizens and both organizations to realize an emergency medical facility; and

WHEREAS, the benefits of such a facility include faster emergency care and patient stabilization, improved response times due to emergency medical crews being available, and enhanced economic vitality and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, both organizations are committed to achieving this goal for our residents whether the provider is Olympic Medical Center or another health care organization; and


WHEREAS, both organizations realize this goal can be accomplished more effectively by working together in partnership.


