RESOLUTION DESIGNATING JAMESTOWN S'KLALLAM TRIBE'S RECOGNITION DAY
AS A DISTRICT HOLIDAY

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLALLAM COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT No. 3, IS DESIGNATING FEBRUARY 10TH, OF EACH YEAR AS A DISTRICT HOLIDAY IN HONOR OF THE DAY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT RE-RECOGNIZED THE JAMESTOWN S'KLALLAM TRIBE AS A SOVEREIGN INDIAN NATION.

BACKGROUND: WHEREAS, in 1855, the Jamestown S'Klallam people signed the Point No Point Treaty with the United States government, ceding millions of acres of land in exchange for government services and retention of their rights to fish, hunt and gather.

WHEREAS, Formal recognition by the United States government publicly acknowledged the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe as a sovereign nation.

WHEREAS, on February 10, 1981, the Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe was officially re-recognized by the United States government as a sovereign Indian Nation.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners agrees to honor the Jamestown S'Klallam's Tribe in recognition of their official re-recognition by the United States government as a sovereign Indian Nation

RESOLUTION: NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Clallam County Fire Protection District No. 3 that February 10th, 2023 and each year thereafter shall be a designated as a Recognized Holiday in recognition of Jamestown S'Klallam Tribe's official re-recognition as a sovereign Indian Nation.
