Q: What is a Line of Duty Death (LODD)?

A: The term Line of Duty Death is used when a death occurs while in the line of duty or from a job-related medical injury covered by RCW 51.32.185. The funeral service may include all honors, procession of service vehicles and assistance.

Q: What is a LODD procession?

A: The procession is a convoy of the deceased's family members, friends, and colleagues. Service apparatus and personnel will be escorting Captain Chad Cate and his family to the service. This is a significant part of the overall Line of Duty Death service.

Q: How can I pay my respects?

A: The public is invited to pay their respects by standing along the route which runs from US 101 north on Sequim Avenue, west on Washington Street, north on 5th Avenue, east on Fir Street and turning north on Sequim Avenue arriving at the Sequim High School. Q: How long will the ceremony take?

A: These types of events usually take an hour and a half to two hours.

Q: What do I do when uniformed personnel stand and salute?

A: When the uniform personnel salute, we humbly request that you place your right hand over your heart (like you are reciting the Pledge of Allegiance).

Q: What if I can't physically make the service but would like to view it?
